APPLICATION FORM EXPLANATION:

ELIGIBILITY: Any Rover within their first two years of Roving.

NUMBER OF SERVICE HOURS WITH CREW: Specify the time period that this person has been with the crew. It would also be useful to indicate the number of service activities that the crew has held during this time period. This does not include Scouting hours, however consideration must be given to the availability of time for the nominee to do service, in job and family commitments.

POSITION HELD IN CREW: If the applicant holds either an elected or appointed position {or has held more than one, please indicate what that position is and for how long they have held it}. A comment on performance would be useful here.

WARRANT HELD: If the applicant holds a warrant as a Leader with another section, please indicate which warrant and with what Group and Zone. Comments from Group Leaders and/or Zone Leaders may be attached to support the application. This includes a warrant in the Guide movement.

ROVER ACTIVITIES ORGANISED: Please attach a brief description of notable activities. This should cover social and fundraising, as well as service activities.

OTHER COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES: Please indicate other relevant service activities, length of involvement and kind of work done at those organisations.

LIST ANY OTHER ATTRIBUTES: The ideal recipient of this award is a person who displays the attributes listed in the Scout Promise and Law. Any examples of these attributes that you can give to support this application should be listed here.

NOMINATIONS: Nominations should be formalised at a Crew business meeting and have the support of the Crew. The Crew Leader and /or Assistant Crew Leader may sign on behalf of the crew.

APPLICATION PERIOD: Please hand your applications to your Regional Rover Leader one-month prior to the start of the moot.
